

Annex A — Price List

Swiss School of Music · Music · Ballet · Performance

The price list forms part of the tuition contract.

1. Semester fees — individual lessons, music and ballet

Price per semester. The first figure applies to the 1st semester, the second to the 2nd semester. The semester fee is a flat amount for the semester concerned. Invoices are issued at the start of each semester.

School year 2026/27: 1st semester from 17.08.2026 to 31.01.2027, 2nd semester from 01.02.2027 to 03.07.2027. The school holidays of the Canton of Zug are excluded. Lessons falling on cantonal public holidays are arranged between the teacher and the family; a cancelled lesson is compensated.

If a student takes two lessons of different durations, these count as two lessons at the 1× per week rate.

2. Group lessons in ballet and dance (children)

Price per semester. The first figure applies to the 1st semester, the second to the 2nd. The number of lessons per week within the same discipline is decisive.

- Ballet, contemporary dance and ballet for figure skaters are separate disciplines; they are not added together but charged individually according to the number of lessons per week.
- The registration fee and the annual administration fee are not included in the group rate (section 5).
- Adult ballet is not covered by this rate — see section 3.

The trial lesson is free — for individual music and ballet lessons as well as for ballet and dance groups, once per subject or per course.

3. Adult ballet

Single lesson: 60 min. CHF 40 · 75 min. CHF 45 · 90 min. CHF 50.

Individual ballet lessons are allocated subject to availability; places are limited and are arranged in advance. The rates in section 1 apply.

4. Additional lessons and masterclasses

45 min. CHF 150 · 60 min. CHF 200.

The fees for the Crescendo music level test and for the Crescendo Talent Award competition are governed by the Regulations for the Crescendo Music Level Test.

5. Fixed fees

- Registration fee (one-off, on joining at the start of a semester): CHF 90.
- Registration fee when joining during a semester: CHF 100. It replaces the CHF 90 fee and is not charged in addition.
- Annual administration fee: CHF 45 per student per school year (an administration fee, not a membership fee). It is charged at the start of each school year and is not refundable.

The registration and administration fees are not refunded even if the contract is terminated during the settling-in period.

6. Additional costs

Charged separately as incurred: examinations, accompanist, workshops, competitions, concerts, intensive courses, teaching materials, costume rental and special events.

Costume rental: CHF 25 per performance. If a costume is damaged beyond repair, the full replacement value is charged.

Rehearsals belonging to a school project that is compulsory for the student are included in the semester fee and are not charged separately (see Annex B).

7. Reductions

All reductions apply solely to tuition fees, not to fixed fees or additional costs.

7.1 Family reduction

The second and each further child receive a 10 % reduction on tuition fees. If a child leaves, the reduction for the remaining children is recalculated from the next invoice.

7.2 Social support (income-based)

Reduction on tuition fees according to the family's taxable income. Written application with proof of income; granted for one school year; subject to the school's financial capacity.

7.3 Tuition scholarships

For students of the music department in the Academy Programme, awarded through the Crescendo Talent Award competition: 1st prize 50 % reduction, 2nd prize 25 %, each for one school year. The procedure is governed by the Regulations for the Crescendo Music Level Test.

7.4 Combining reductions

Where there is entitlement to more than one reduction, only the larger is granted unless the school has agreed otherwise in writing. Social support and the family reduction are not combined.

Note — insurance reimbursement (not a school reduction)

The school is a member of Tanzvereinigung Schweiz. A number of health insurers reimburse parents for part of the cost of dance and movement classes with recognised providers under supplementary insurance. Whether and to what extent a reimbursement is made is decided solely by the insurer according to its own schedule; the school grants no reduction in this connection and has no influence on the decision. Please contact your health insurer directly. On request, the school issues confirmation of the lessons attended and of its membership of Tanzvereinigung.

8. Payment

Fees are invoiced in advance at the start of each semester and are payable within 30 days of the invoice date. Each invoice must be paid separately (scan the QR code) so that the payment can be allocated automatically.

If payment is not received, the school may suspend tuition until the balance is settled in full; suspended lessons are neither made up nor refunded. The school may then initiate debt collection proceedings. Debt collection costs and default interest of 5 % under Art. 104 of the Swiss Code of Obligations are borne by the parents.

9. Price changes

The school may change its rates with effect from the start of a new school year. Parents are informed in text form by 30 April at the latest. If they do not agree, they may — by way of derogation from section 5.3 of the tuition contract — terminate the contract within 30 days of the notification with effect from the end of the current school year. The amended price list becomes part of the tuition contract.
